Information about the April 8, 2024 Eclipse

A total solar eclipse will be visible from many parts of the US on April 8, 2024. While no location in Massachusetts will experience totality, some parts of the state will see over 95% coverage of the sun if weather permits. The eclipse will begin shortly after 2 PM ET and will last about 2 and a half hours until about 4:30 PM ET.

The eclipse may overlap with dismissal for many Massachusetts schools. Preparation to safely view

Application Form:

Essay: Please submit an essay that relays your motivations and intentions for furthering your education and how your time at Erving Elementary School impacted that decision. Please Include such information as:

- Your chosen field of study and why that field interests you
- Your career objectives, if you have any at this time
- How this assistance will benefit you
- Why should we choose you to receive one of these scholarships?

***Essays should be typed in 12-point font and double-spaced.

Reference: Please submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher or professor.

Criteria: Each of the two scholarship selection committees will carefully review all applications and will choose one recipient. Consideration will be given to:

- quality of the essay
- academic success and the applicant's commitment to his/her continuing education
- dedication to school and community

The **ETA** scholarship will be awarded after the documented successful completion of your first semester for use in your second term.

The **P.I.E.E.** scholarship will be awarded at Awards Night ceremonies for graduation to be used for first semester expenses.

Please submit your completed application to the address above by May 1st, 2024. The Erving Elementary staff and P.I.E.E. members are looking forward to hearing from you. We all send our best wishes as you move into this next wonderful stage of your life.
